## **STUDENT'S FEEDBACK**

### **ANALYZATION REPORT**

**2018-19**

The feedback was obtained from 80 students and the findings can be listed as follows:-

- About 42.5% of the students revealed that the syllabus covered in the class amount to 70-84%.
- Regarding teacher's preparation for the class, 53.75% of the students felt that it is satisfactory.
- About 55% of the students revealed that the teacher's ability to communicate was sometimes effective.
- About 42.5% of the students described the teacher's approach to teaching as good.
- About 51.25% of the students showed that the internal evaluation process by the teacher was always fair.
- About 45% of the students revealed that their performance in assignments was discussed with them every time.
- About 42.5% of the students revealed that the institute regularly takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities.
- About 53.75% of the students voiced out that the teaching and mentoring process in the college has very well facilitated them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
- About 58.75% of the students agreed that the institute provides opportunities to learn and grow.
- About 48.75% of the students pointed out that the teachers informed them every time about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.
- About 35% of the students showed that their mentor usually does a necessary follow up with an assigned task to students.
- About 40% of the students revealed that every time the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

- About 58.75% of the students felt that the teachers fully identified the student's strength and encourage them by providing right level of challenges.
- About 47.5% of the students revealed that the teachers were able to identify the student's weakness and helped the students to overcome them every time.
- About 47.5% of the students agreed that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
- About 40% of the students showed that the institute and its teachers moderately use student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
- About 50% of the students agreed that the teachers encourage them to participate in extra-curricular activities.
- About 32.5% of the students revealed that efforts are made by the institute/Teachers to a great extent to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the students ready for the world of work.
- About 45% of the students voiced out that the use of ICT tools while teaching is very poor.
- About 50% of the students agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.

### **Suggestions**

Some of the suggestions given by the students are as follows:-

- Digital technology should be implemented in the college.
- Strict attendance should be maintained.
- More awareness/ positive programmes on teaching and learning methods should be conducted.
- Teachers should give the chance to students to give their feedbacks after teaching.
- Teachers should prepare themselves very well before coming to class.
- Experiential learning in the form of field trips and study tour should be undertaken from time to time.
- Teachers should motivate the students for a better career and future.
- Teachers should give explanation by giving suitable examples.
- Teachers should spend more time on explaining rather than giving notes.

- Teachers should support the students when they are facing problems or difficulties.
- The college should provide wifi connectivity to the students.
- Teachers should spend more time on teaching rather than organizing programmes.
- Teachers should cover the whole syllabus.
